Here are a few suggestions to raise scholarship funds for "Send a Kid to Camp." Request a copy of the promotional DVD "Pilgrim Point Camp" from the PPC office or download the video from the PPC web site to use for a visual presentation with any or all of the ideas. www.pilgrimpoint.org

"Party for Camp" Pilgrim Point Camp has been changing lives for over 50 years. Have a party and encourage gifts for camperships for children in your church and for the camp scholarship fund.

Designate a Sunday Worship service for a **"Camp Promotion."** The service can include personal testimonies from previous campers, camp songs, camp liturgies and a designated offering envelope.

Ask church members to prepare soups that can be served for a **"Soup and Bread Luncheon,"** with donations designated for camp scholarships.

Ask congregation members to donate items for a **"Silent Auction,"** and use proceeds to fund camp scholarships.

"Church Rummage Sales" have the potential to generate great camp scholarship dollars.

A **"Mother's Day Brunch"** is another opportunity to raise scholarship funds. Youth and adults from the congregation can prepare and serve a brunch after worship service on Mother's Day

"Community Fun Night," invite people for a night of carnival type activities. Possibilities include a cake walk, fishing pond, face painting, Bingo, bean bag toss, concessions, etc.

"Free Concert" Find volunteer individuals and groups from your church and community to share their musical talents. Receive a free will donation and sell concessions for added income.
